
WHEREAS, this solicitation was sponsored by the National Association of Counties/Financial Services Center (NACO/FSC) with Dallas County serving as the lead agency; and


WHEREAS, this award will be available to local governments throughout the country through an interlocal agreement; and

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Dallas County Commissioners Court does hereby authorize awarding RFP No. 2005-131-1713, Request for Proposal for Cost Recovery/Cost Containment Program to Maximus, Employee Relations, Correctional Risk Services, Cost Control Associates, D-MED and Dickstein Shapiro for an initial three (3) year period beginning October 12, 2005 through October 11, 2008, with two (2) one year options to extend.


